We may be able to add ABWM to the rotation for every 4th year. I hope to make the goal this year, though that amount has been difficult in the past and we got a late start due to the turmoil of the by-law changes last spring. I also realize that this project is specified for scholarships and not the general fund, but that's what was decided. We took a collection at our Spring conference and shared half with national. That collection is where we get most of our operating funds. We may have to go back to 10% next year but appreciated Gina and

My report to the Board at our meeting prior to the start of the Spiritual Growth Retreat, showed that our General Fund balance is currently \$1,270.59. That is quite a bit lower than it was last year at this time. In order to pay our expenses (website maintenance, be a Vital Partner, stamps, paper, etc.) we need to receive contributions/dues to our General Fund. Please keep that in mind.

We collected enough for the Women and Girls Fund to be able to send \$1,222.91 to it... Also, with much help from people not associated with ABWM, plus a matching gift, we were able to send \$38,520.94 to our State Project which was Camp Koinonia. Now it is time to collect for our NEW State Project.

Scholarship applications must be submitted to American Baptist Women's Ministries by June 30. All applicants will receive written notification regarding funding decisions by August 30.
